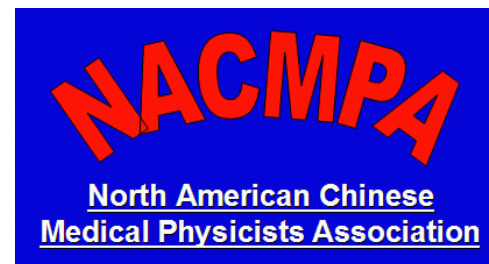

Hangzhou Meeting (2006)

The International Congress of Medical Physics meeting to be held at Hangzhou, China on September 3-6, 2006 is sponsored by the NACMPA, AAPM Asian Oceanic Affairs Subcommittee, and Chinese Society of Medical Physics (CSMP). The aim of this meeting is to bring together the planned participants of the Chinese Society of Radiation Oncology (CSRO) Radiation Physics Committee and participants of the World Congress in Korea to the scenic water front conference center in Hangzhou, China. There are planned refresher courses, invited talks, and also oral scientific sessions. The meeting will also address imaging issues related to IMRT and IGRT. Travel Award (2006)

For the first time, NACMPA has issued travel awards to support its members to attend the International Congress of Medical Physics in Hangzhou, China. In addition, NACMPA also supported invited speakers. The amount of each travel award is \$800.
