### China GW2010 Meeting (August 18-22, 2010)

The Great Wall 2010 International Congress on Medical Physics to be held in Nanjing, China on August 18-22, 2010. The congress is hosted by Chinese Society of Medical Physics (CSMP) and North American Chinese Medical Physicists Association (NACMPA), and organized by China Eastern Radiation Physics Committee (ERPC) and Jiangsu Cancer Hospital. This congress will be held in parallel with 15<sup>th</sup> National Annual Meeting of Medical Physics And with 3<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of China Eastern Radiation Physics Committee.

This congress is intended to facilitate scientific exchange, to promote medical physics research, application and education, and to provide a platform for medical physicists and scientists in related fields worldwide to foster communications, collaborations and friendship. The theme of the congress is “**Better Medical Physics, Better Human Health**”. The contents will cover all aspects of medical physics such as radiation therapy physics, medical imaging physics, health physics, blood rheology, laser, ultrasound, bioinformatics and medical physics education, etc. Major topics will include image-guided radiotherapy, bio-functional imaging, 3D and intensity-modulated radiotherapy, Monte Carlo methods, radiation safety and quality, image processing methods and radiobiological modeling.

## Partners-In-Physics (PIP) Program

NACMPA had been supporting the PIP program of the AAPM by sponsoring up to 15 medical physicists per year from developing countries in the Asian Pacific region. As a sponsor, NACMPA pays AAPM dues for the PIP. The medical physicist partner in the developing countries can access the AAPM website and its electronic resources including medical physics journal and TG-reports. Effective 2008, the PIP dues has been eliminated and the AAPM Board had decided to allocate 300 free PIPs for the developing countries. Interested medical physicists in developing countries can apply to become Corresponding Member or International Affiliate at the AAPM website (<http://www.aapm.org/>). To apply as a PIP, the applicant must check “yes” for the question “Financial Assistance Needed?” Application instructions are available at our NACMPA website (<http://www.nacmpa.org>). The PIP program is under the International Affairs Committee (IAC) of the AAPM chaired by Raymond Wu, PhD.
