China LiJiang International Conference (June 9-12, 2011)

The International Conference specifically for Chinese Radiation Oncologists and Medical Physicists around the world, China was held on June 9 to 12, 2011. The conference is hosted by Chinese Society for Therapeutic Radiology & Oncology (CSTRO) and North American Chinese Medical Physicists Association (NACMPA).

The theme of the conference is ***“Better Treatment Plan, Better QA, Better Outcome –Opportunity and Challenge in Radiation Oncology, Medical Physics and Technology”***. The conference features a panel discussion for all participants’ sharing their opinions and experience in designing treatment scheme, treatment plan, patient QA, and treatment outcome. Representatives from multiple institutions will lead a round table discussion in comparison of treatment plans, patient QA and patient outcome assessment. The round table discussion is very well received by the attendees. Total of 300 attendees, including Radiation Oncologists and Residents, Medical Physicists, post-doctors, and students, attended this meeting. NACMPA attendees are Drs. Partners-In-Physics (PIP) Program

NACMPA had been supporting the PIP program of the AAPM by sponsoring up to 15 medical physicists per year from developing countries in the Asian Pacific region. As a sponsor, NACMPA pays AAPM dues for the PIP. The medical physicist partner in the developing countries can access the AAPM website and its electronic resources including medical physics journal and TG-reports. Effective 2008, the PIP dues has been eliminated and the AAPM Board had decided to allocate 300 free PIPs for the developing countries. Interested medical physicists in developing countries can apply to become Corresponding Member or International Affiliate at the AAPM website (<http://www.aapm.org/>). To apply as a PIP, the applicant must check “yes” for the question “Financial Assistance Needed?” Application instructions are available at our NACMPA website (<http://www.nacmpa.org>). The PIP program is under the International Affairs Committee (IAC) of the AAPM chaired by Raymond Wu, PhD.

Financial Support for Mr. Yibao Zhang to attend AAPM 2011 Annual meeting at Vancouver, BC

NACMPA executive officers and Board of directors have approved the amount of \$250 to partially support Mr. Yibao Zhang attending the 2011 Joint AAPM/COMP Meeting at Vancouver, BC. Mr. Yibao Zhang, a Ph.D. student of Peking University, is currently a visiting Ph.D. student at the Yale University. Mr. Zhang’s abstract was accepted for an oral presentation in the 2011 joint AAPM/COMP meeting. He will also receive other financial supports from AO and IAC of AAPM and Yale University. The guidelines for awarding financial support to oversea graduate students, post-doctors and fellows will be posted on the NACMPA web-site after the 2011 annual meeting at Vancouver.
